Call to Order:

Lori Gutierrez, co-chairperson, called the meeting to order at 10:08 a.m.

I. Introductions

Ms. Gutierrez welcomed the committee members and guests.

II. Review and approval of December 5, 2017 SOP Committee minutes.

A motion was made by Jennifer Ernst and seconded by Belinda Weiss to accept the minutes. Motion carried.

III. Advisory Opinions reviewed/approved at the January 25, 2018 Board Meeting

- A. Amniotomy/Fetal Spinal Electrodes
- B. Blood Cell Salvage
- C. Intubation: Endotracheal and The Use of Advanced Airway Devices
- D. Ultrasounds: Limited Obstetric, Gynecological and Reproductive
- E. Wound Care: Role of the RN & LPN
- F. External Ventricular Drain Management, Cerebral Spinal Fluid Sampling and Line Flushing

IV. Review of current advisory opinions

A. Medical Esthetic Procedures Performed by Licensed Nurses -

MK Maloney and Jennifer Ernst discussed the desire/intent to include a collaborative effort on this advisory opinion with the Nursing Board, Cosmetology Board, and Bureau of Radiation Control. Ernst reviewed levels currently described in the advisory opinion and the need to obtain additional input from Cosmetology and Bureau of Radiation Control. Suggestion was made to set up a task force meeting for further discussion with these boards, to address subjects such as roles of cosmetologists, aestheticians, certified laser techs, LPN's and RN's; required education, new procedures that are developed, locations where these procedures are performed, supervision of certified laser techs, etc.

Recommendation: /Action Taken/Responsible For: Set up a meeting in April, 2018, with Representation from Board of Nursing, Cosmetology Board, Bureau of Radiation Control, Scope of Practice Committee and Department of Health Services to further discuss/clarify medical esthetic issues that affect these agencies.

Responsible Person: Judy Bontrager

B. Infusion Therapy Role of the LPN – Discussion cancelled

C. Tumescant Lidocaine Injection: Role of the RN - Peggy Hampton discussed the possibility of combining information from current advisory opinions that include sedation, local anesthetics, etc. (currently have 8 different advisory opinions relating to these areas) into one advisory opinions. Multiple questions are received by the Board relating to anesthetics. It was felt by the SOP

Committee that one comprehensive advisory opinion addressing this subject would provide more complete information regarding administration of anesthetics vs. one opinion that addresses one anesthetic agent's use in one scenario. Helpful suggestions were received from Randy Quinn, CRNA and President of the Board of Nursing after he reviewed a first draft of a comprehensive advisory opinion on Sedation: The Role of the RN.

Recommendation/Responsible For: Set up meeting with Randy Quinn, Lori Gutierrez and several members of SOP Committee to obtain input on a 2nd draft advisory opinion– Judy Bontrager.

D. Intravenous Administration of Radiologic Contrast Media – Peggy Hampton led this discussion. It was recommended to add that the supervising physician be physically present in the facility to treat the patient in the event of an adverse contrast reaction. References were also updated.

Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For: A motion was made by Beth Nillen and seconded by Josie Prinz, to take the revised draft to the March 22-23, 2018, Board Meeting. Motion carried. Responsible person – Judy Bontrager

E. Anesthetics Agents Administered by RN's for Limited Purposes: Airway Management or Peripheral Nerve Block. – This advisory opinion (originated by Advance Practice Committee) was taken to January Board Meeting and the Board approved changes to delete Peripheral Nerve Block

F. Subcutaneous Infusion – Judy Irvin noted purposed changes included under the instructional program. References were updated.

Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For: A motion was made by Peggy Hampton and seconded by Judy Irvin, to take the revised draft to the March 22-23, 2018, Board Meeting. Motion carried. Responsible person – Judy Bontrager

G. Apheresis Donor – Role of the LPN – Lori Murphy noted the references were updated. It was decided to not take this advisory opinion to the Board until after SOP meeting on August 28, 2018, when the advisory opinion on Informed Consent will be discussed.

Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For: A motion was made by Beth Nillen and seconded by Peggy Hampton.

H. Ventilator Care by Licensed Practice Nurses – Jamie Cowgur led the discussion. Discussion was held regarding the LPN role to change the outer canula of trach patients. It was decided to include outer canula exchange for emergent situations only.

Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For: A motion was made by Susan Arbogast and seconded by Eryn Draganski, to take the revised draft to March 22 – 23, 2018 Board Meeting – Motion carried. Responsible person – Judy Bontrager

V. Requests to Develop New Advisory Opinions

A. Instilling and tPA and DNase: Eryn Draganski led the discussion for nurse to instill tPA and DNase into a pigtail or chest. Eryn describe the procedure that is currently being done at Mayo in Minnesota. This procedure is used to break up clots in the plural space. After discussion the group requested Draganski to do a draft advisory opinion for consideration at the SOP June meeting.

Recommendation/Action Take/Responsible For: Present draft advisory opinion on medication instillation into the pleural cavity for consideration at June 2018 SOP meeting
Responsible person – Eryn Draganski

- B. Hemodialysis: Role of the RN/LPN Advisory Opinion** – A request was received to write a new advisory opinion on Hemodialysis. Volunteers included **Eryn Draganski**, Jamie Cowgur, Belindsa Weiss, Lori Murphy to present a draft at the August 28, 2018 SOP meeting.
