**Call to Order:**

Lori Gutierrez, co-chairperson called the meeting to order at 10:05 am.

**I. Introductions**

Ms. Gutierrez asked the guests in the audience to introduce themselves.

**II. Review and Approval of June 5, 2018 minutes.**

A motion was made by Belinda Weiss and seconded by Beth Nillen to accept the minutes. Motion carried.

**III. Advisory Opinions reviewed/approved at the July 26-27, 2018 Board Meeting.**

- A. Cardiac Electrophysiology Related Procedures – The Role of the RN
- B. Prescription Medication Renewals Using a Nursing Protocol in an Ambulatory Setting
- C. Local Anesthetic Agents Infiltrations: Role of the Nurse
- D. Administration of tPA & DNase via Pigtail or Chest Tube (<15FR) for Pleural Effusion/Empyema

**IV. Review of current Advisory Opinions**

**A. Informed Consent**

Peggy Hampton initiated the discussion on what current facility policies included. Jane Sederstrom raised the question about who is responsible for getting informed consent for HIV related testing and brought A.R.S. 32-663 to our attention.

**Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For**

Subcommittee will continue additional research for further discussion at December 4, 2018 meeting – Christina Ryan

**B. Apheresis Donor: Role of the LPN**

Lori Murphy noted more clarification was added to therapeutic apheresis definition, and that a Licensed Independent Provider (LIP) should be available for consult via telephone. References were updated.

**Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For**

Motion made by Peggy Hampton, seconded by Eryn Draganski, to take to September, 2018, Board Meeting for approval.

**C. Intravenous Administration of Radiologic Contrast Media**

Judy Bontrager reported that there were only 28 hits on the website during the past 6 months. Jennifer Ernest noted contrast media also being given via intra-osseous method. Some facilities have techs administering contrast media.

**Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For**

Motion made by Belinda Weiss and seconded by Kim Day to retire this Advisory Opinion and

incorporate aspects with the Interosseous Cannulation and Removal Advisory Opinion when revised in 2019.

**D. Sedation/Analgesia (moderate, deep, nitrous, palliative/anesthetics) Administered by RN's**

Judy Bontrager shared input from Randy Quinn regarding the draft advisory opinion which was a combination of several advisory opinions. After further discussion, direction will focus on not combining CRNA Epidural Analgesia, Nitrous Oxide Administrations, Anesthetic Agents Administered by RN's, and determining if it would be appropriate to combine any of the others. Dr. Kim Maryniak volunteered to lead this review.

**Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For**

Bring recommendations for new revisions related to Sedation/Analgesia to Scope of Practice Committee on December 4, 2018 – Dr. Kim Maryniak

**E. Chronic Hemodialysis in Ambulatory Care Facility – Role of LPN**

Jamie Cowgur reviewed the proposed changes/additions. It is limited to hemodialysis (excludes self-care home dialysis and peritoneal dialysis) References were updated.

**Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For**

A motion was made by Jane Sederstrom, seconded by Cheryl Roth to take the revised draft to September Board Meeting – motion carried. Responsible person – Judy Bontrager

**F. Stress Testing: Pharmacological**

Jane Sederstrom noted that it is becoming more commonplace for RN's to administer medications and suggested this advisory opinion could be retired. After discussion Beth Nillan make a motion to retire and Jennifer Ernest seconded the motion. All members approved.

**Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For**

Retire Advisory Opinion

**G. Medical Esthetic Procedures Performed by Licensed Nurses**

MK Maloney informed committee that the draft has been reviewed by Bureau of Radiation Control, Arizona Board of Cosmetology, and the Scope of Practice Committee. It will now be sent to the Advanced Practice Committee for their additions in the October Advance Practice Committee meeting, and hopefully to the Board for approval in November, 2018.

**K. Contrast Media Injection in Coronary Arteries**

Jami Cowgur reviewed revised format changes and stated the references were updated.

**Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For**

A motion was made by Judy Irvin, seconded by Eileen Smith, to take the revised draft to September Board Meeting – motion carried. Responsible person – Judy Bontrager

**L. Central Venous Catheter Insertion/Removal for the Adult Population by RN's**

Judy Irvin noted that other states had similar content in their advisory opinions. A discussion ensued on tunneled catheters vs cuffed or balloon catheters. It was suggested that this advisory opinion be combined with the advisory opinion on PICC lines. It was also suggested that umbilical catheters be included.


