Call to Order:

Lori Gutierrez, co-chairperson, called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

I. Introductions

Ms. Gutierrez welcomed the committee members and guests.

II. Review and approval of March 6, 2018 SOP Committee minutes.

A motion was made by Beth Nillen and seconded by Kim Day to accept the minutes. Motion carried.

III. Advisory Opinions reviewed/approved at the March 22-23, 2018 Board Meeting

A. Ventilator Care by LPN's (approved)

B. Subcutaneous Infusion (approved)

C. Intravenous Administration of Radiologic Contrast Media (not approved). Committee discussed option to retire this advisory opinion. It was noted that new nurses are being employed in radiology and this advisory opinion may be a good reference.

Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsibility For: Determine the number of hits this advisory opinion has. Discuss at 8/28/2018 meeting for final decision.

IV. Review of current advisory opinions

A. Cardiac Electrophysiology Related Procedures – The Role of the RN

Jaime Cowgur described the suggested changes for consideration: deleting the descriptor of “extra pair of hands,” title change, clarification that RN's may not manipulate cardiac catheters within the coronary artery, and updating references. Cowgur noted that in many facilities the cardiologist do procedure with technicians.

Recommendation: /Action Taken/Responsible For: A motion was made by Eryn Draganski, seconded by Christina Ryan to take the revised draft to July 26-27, 2018 Board Meeting – motion carried.

Responsible Person: Judy Bontrager

B. Pre Hospital Nursing – Kim Day reviewed considerations for changes in the advisory opinion: Should this be for LPN's? Whose authority is the nurse working under?, etc.

Recommendation: To continue additional research and return advisory opinion draft to August 28, 2018 SOP meeting. Responsible person: Kim Day

C. Prescription Medication Renewals Using a Nursing Protocol – Belinda Weiss discussed this advisory opinion. There were questions regarding the statement about prescription medication renewal timeframe so this statement was deleted. References were updated.

Recommendation/Responsible For: A motion was made by Derek Moore, seconded by Jennifer Ernst to take the revised draft to July 26-27, 2018 Board Meeting – motion carried. Responsible person– Judy Bontrager.

D. Sedation/Analgesia (moderate, deep, nitrous, palliative/anesthetics administered by RN's) – Postponed to August 28, 2018 meeting.

E. Intradermal, Subcutaneous and Submucosal Infiltration of Local Anesthetic Agents:

Role of the Nurse – Jennifer Ernst described the emergence of combining Tumescent Lidocaine with diluent solution for liposuction as well as burn patients, laser resurfacing, release of contractions, etc. The literature is recommending less drug when possible without compromising patient comfort level. It is not within the Scope of Practice for an LPN to administer tumescent lidocaine. Dr. Cheryl Roth noted that other revisions including definitions, increased clarity in the general requirement and rationale. References were also updated. Title was changed to local anesthetic agents infiltration.

Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For: A motion was made by Eryn Draganski, seconded by Beth Nillen to take the revised advisory draft to July 26-27, 2018 Board Meeting – motion carried. Responsible person: Judy Bontrager

F. Medical Esthetic Procedure Performed by Licensed Nurses – MK Maloney and Jennifer Ernst updated the SOP Committee on the meeting that have been held with AZ Board of Cosmetology and the Bureau of Radiation Control. The idea of including information from 3 agencies has been well received. An additional statement will be included to note that the advisory opinion was done in conjunction with the other two agencies, noting specifically that the Board of Nursing does not have jurisdiction of care providers that are not included in the Nurse Practice Act.

Recommendation/Action Taken/Responsible For: To meet with the Board of Cosmetology and Bureau of Radiation Control on June 22, 2018 and finalize draft recommendations. Return to SOP Committee on August 28, 2018.

G. Central Venous Catheter Insertion/Removal for the Adult Population by RNs – Postponed to August 28, 2018 meeting

V. New Topics

A. SOP Committee Self Evaluation: Each committee member was asked to complete an evaluation rating the effectiveness of the committee. Results will be provided to the committee on August 28, 2018

B. Medication Instillation into the Pleural Cavity – Eryn Draganski presented the draft for a new advisory opinion, a result of a request from Mayo staff to implement a new procedure.

Recommendation/Action Take/Responsible For: A motion was made by Eryn Draganski, seconded by Jennifer Ernst to take the draft to the July 26-27, 2018 Board Meeting – motion carried. Responsible person – Judy Bontrager
